Vaccine	What is it?	Kittens	Adult Cats
FLVK Feline Leukemia and Distemper combination	Leukemia affects the immune system and lowers the cats ability to fight off common diseases.	Feline Leukemia test prior to Vaccination. If negative, a vaccination should be given. Then vaccine will need to be boosted in one month.	Annually
FVRCP Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia, Chlamydia, Psittaci	Distemper combination vaccine covers many respiratory diseases that may be fatal.	3 doses spread one month apart for full immunity.	Annually
Rabies	Rabies is fatal and can be passed to any human or animal.	1 dose at 4-6 months of age	Annually
Fecal Check	Parasites are easily contracted. They are passed from animal to animal and to humans as well.	De-worm with first shots. A fecal check should be performed at least once before spay or neuter age (6 months).	Biannually (even for indoor cats).
Flea Preventative *Advantage/Program*	Either a once a month topical product called Advantage or a 6 month shot called Program . Both work well.	Year round , Fleas can live in carpet and furniture and reproduce VERY quickly.	Year round even for indoor cats, it takes 1 flea to make a million.
