

A Foaling Kit Should Include

- Cell phone (with Dr. Winter's phone number)
 - Headlamp
 - Watch
 - Tail wrap for mare
 - Gloves
 - Lubricant
 - Towels (to provide grip if you have to grasp foal's legs and pull).
 - Stethoscope
 - Bulb syringe (for aspirating fluids from foal, if necessary).
 - Serrated knife (for cutting the sack, if needed).
 - Trash bag (to save placenta for Dr. Winter to evaluate).
 - Disinfectant (Nolvasan or iodine), for dipping naval stump
 - Enema (Discuss with Dr. Winter first)
- * After your foal has arrived, call CVS to schedule an appointment for Dr. Winter to perform a neonatal exam.**
